**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
For use by DOMESTIC NONPROFIT CORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of Act 162, Public Acts of 1982, the undersigned corporation executes the following Articles:

**ARTICLE I**

The name of the corporation is:

SUDANESE AMERICAN SOCCER FEDERATION FOR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

**ARTICLE II**

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

Objectives and General Principles

1. Programs for Youth Development:

To provide programs and activities aimed at developing the skills of youth and young adults of both genders across various fields, including amateur sports, culture, education, and the arts.

2. Promotion of Ethics and Teamwork:

To instill moral values, sportsmanship, leadership qualities, teamwork, and social responsibility in young generations.

3. Scholarships and Training Opportunities:

To seek scholarships at U.S. universities or training programs for outstanding youth in sports and cultural activities.

4. Collaboration with Institutions:

To work with local and international organizations to support educational and developmental programs targeting youth and adolescents.

5. Support for Community Development Initiatives:

To utilize available resources to promote community initiatives that encourage youth participation and foster societal development.

6. Sports Events and Social Connections:

To organize diverse amateur sporting competitions and events that strengthen family ties and create positive social relationships among youth.

7. International Relations:

To coordinate and establish communication channels between the Sudanese American Soccer Federation and other relevant organizations to enhance youth engagement.

8. Educational Programs:

To offer educational programs aimed at empowering youth and enabling them to contribute effectively to their local communities in the U.S.

9. Cultural Identity:

To nurture a love for their homeland among Sudanese descendants and familiarize them with Sudan's diverse cultural heritage.

10. Talent Development:

To focus on the growth of talents and capabilities in various fields, including sports, culture, arts, and theater, for youth of all genders.

11. Promoting Unity and Peace:

To elevate the cultural, social, and athletic standards among Sudanese individuals while promoting unity and peace, free from political or regional biases, in adherence to Sudanese traditions.

12. Sportsmanship and Representation:

To promote the concept of sports as a symbol of honor, ethics, and a cultural ambassador between nations.

13. Specialized Committees:

To establish specialized committees, including those for youth, women, and families, under the supervision of the Executive Committee.

14. Advisory Committee:

To form an advisory committee consisting of five members, including three former presidents of the Federation and an individual with expertise in sports regulations, to support the Executive Committee and assist in resolving disputes during tournaments.
